#### Aim

#### Overview

Students come to the AWL Qld Sanctuary and work through a range of hands-on and theory components. Those who demonstrate the outcomes required receive an AWL Qld Certificate of Achievement at the end of the course.

#### Practical components:

*Basic Dog Obedience Training Skills  
Practical Cat Care  
Dog Socialisation  
Dog Hydrobathing and Grooming Skills  
Dog Breed Identification*

#### Theory components:

*Laws and Animals  
Choosing the right dog breed for your lifestyle  
Veterinary Care for Dogs and Cats  
Cat Breed types & Identification  
Responsible Cat and Dog Care*

PLEASE NOTE: Some components may be omitted in some course structures

#### Course Structure

There are 3 different models to choose from. Courses can also be structured to meet the needs of your school. Days and times are negotiated with the school.

- 8-10 hour course: E.g. 8 or 10 x 1 hour sessions over one term
- 12-16 hour course: E.g. 6 or 8 x 2hr sessions or 1 hour per week over a semester
- 20 hour course: E.g. 5 days with a 4hr session each day

#### Course Costs

- 12-16 hour course \$88.00 per student
- 20 hour course \$110.00 per student
